- We want to welcome everyone back to school. We especially want to welcome new students who are enrolled in Preschool through 8th Grade. - Kangaroo Time is our new check-in/check-out system for morning and aftercare. All

students and parents must be registered in the system in order for your child to stay in morning or aftercare. Even if you do not plan to utilize morning and aftercare on a regular basis we still ask that you register with Kangaroo Time in case of an emergency and your child should need to stay. - Please remember that along with the Driver's Form, the school needs a copy of your Driver's License and insurance card to complete the process for driving on fieldtrips. Copies can be made in the office or you can send a copy in.
- For the safety of everyone, please follow drop-off and pick-up procedures. The parking lot has one entrance and one exit during school hours. Please enter off Ave. C and exit to 2nd Street. Bates Ave. is a one way street. If you need to park on Bates Ave. please park in the parking lot and not along the street.
- There will be a slight change in pick up locations starting Monday, August 13. Kindergarten will be in the circle drive in front of the Preschool Office. 1st, 4th and 5th grade will have pick up in the parking lot. 2nd, 3rd, and Middle School students will be picked up on Bates. Ave. This change is to ensure the safety of our students.
- Please remember that our uniform policy states that both tops and bottoms for students in grades K-8 must be purchased through Sir Walter Uniforms. Bottoms should not be purchased from any other outside vendor. Students should also have belt with the exception of kindergarten students who at this time are not required to wear one. Shoes must be closed toe and no sandal of any kind. We recommend students wear tennis shoes.

- School lunch menus are in both the Preschool and K-8 office. Remember lunch orders should be posted 48 hours in advance of the day your child orders lunch. You can complete the calendar and turn it into the office and your child's lunch order will be updated by us or we encourage you to log onto RenWeb and order lunch through there. **If your child is going to be tardy please call the school office no later than 9:00 to let us know your child needs a school lunch. After 9:00 we cannot guarantee a school lunch can be provided.**
