- **There was an error on the February calendar that was sent home last week. There is no MS Youth Group on Wednesday, February 20.**

- Reenrollment has begun. You must complete your child's reenrollment on RenWeb. Please make sure that you are doing this on a computer as you cannot do it on a cellphone. Reenrollment is not complete until you have paid your registration fee (preschool) or tuition deposit (Grades K-8). **If you do not pay your registration fee or tuition deposit by February 28<sup>th</sup> a \$150 late fee will be applied and your child's seat is no longer secure until payment is made.**
- Applications for Financial Assistance through Grace Lutheran School for the 2019-2020 opened on February 4. The application for assistance is through FACTS. Complete your application and submit your supportive paperwork to FACTS. **All families applying for tuition assistance must also submit a letter to Mr. Rottmann explaining reason for need and any additional extenuating circumstances that may affect your financial status.** Once it is complete, FACTS will provide Grace with information to determine financial assistance. Current families have until May 2nd, to complete the process. This is a needs based assistance. Awards will not exceed 50% for Pre-School Applications and will not exceed 65% for Kindergarten-8th grade. Go to [www.factsmtg.com](http://www.factsmtg.com) to apply. - Reminder that all accounts must be paid in full by Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>. Diplomas for 8<sup>th</sup> graders, report cards, and transcripts will not be released until all accounts are paid in full.
- **Please remember when packing your child's daily snack we ask that you are packing them a healthy snack to eat. Please do not send chips or cookies for their morning snack. We encourage a healthy snack as this is your child's "brain food" to get them through until lunch time. Thank you for your cooperation.**

The Scholastic Book Fair is coming to Grace!

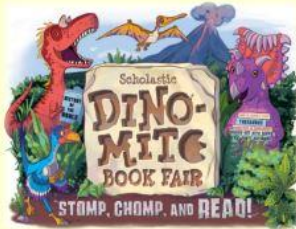
